

PROFESSIONAL TRAINING, CBRF APPROVED TRAINING

Challenge Center provides state approved trainings to meet the needs of agency staff and other human service agencies in the community

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The CBRF Approved Trainings were designed to meet the needs of staff of the Challenge Center. Due to the diverse population Challenge Center serves, the trainings were approved by the state for adults with developmental disabilities as well as aging and mental health populations. Trainings that are offered to in house staff are also opened up to outside agencies.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To produce competent staff that are able to provide the best services to our consumers.
2. To provide Challenge Center staff with training to meet Federal, State regulatory needs.
3. To provide Challenge Center staff with current information to meet the changing needs of consumers.

PLACE OF PROVISION OF SERVICES:

The State Approved Training Services of the Challenge Center are typically provided at the main facility. Off site trainings can be arranged through the Staff Development Coordinator.

METHODS OF PROVISION OF SERVICES:

The Staff Development Coordinator schedules trainings and circulates training schedules to staff, managers and other residential homes in the community. A training schedule line can also be reached on our phone system. Trainings are listed on a month to month basis. ELIGIBILITY:

The CBRF State Approved Training Services of the Challenge Center provides training for people who work with individuals with developmental disabilities, people who are aging, and individuals with mental health concerns.
