

SENSORY STIMULATION PROGRAM

The Sensory Stimulation Program provides services for adults with severe and profound developmental disabilities and special needs. These areas include sensory-motor skills, therapeutic positioning, recreation, and a work component program.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Sensory Stimulation Program is designed to provide participants with prevocational training and activities. The focus is to assist these individuals towards maximizing their potential and maintaining it in functional activities, personal care, communication, and awareness of self and the environment. This is accomplished through individualized programming to meet the specific needs of each client that enhance their quality of life.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Provide sensory stimulation including tactile, visual, vestibular, proprioception, and auditory activities.
2. Provide individual programming to facilitate gross and fine motor skill development.
3. Improve individualized prevocational skills with the aid of adaptive modalities.
4. Increase self and environmental awareness.
5. Improve communication skills to include offering opportunities for choices.
6. Provide personal care services and Activities of Daily Living.

PLACE OF PROVISION OF SERVICES:

Sensory Stimulation Program meets at the Challenge Center.

METHODS OF PROVISION OF SERVICES:

The program is supervised by the Sensory Stimulation Program Team Leader and assisted by Personal Care/Sensory Specialists and Assistants. The Sensory Stimulation Program is a part of the Challenge Center Day Services Program, overseen by the Day Services Director. Referral information by the sponsoring agency, organization, school or County Case Managers should be submitted to the Client Service Coordinator of the Challenge Center, telephone (715) 394-2771. Transportation needs to be arranged prior to entry into the program.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Sensory Stimulation Program serves adults with severe and profound developmental disabilities with special needs and limitations.
